Spring 2011 Coffs Ambassadors Tours

Solitary Islands Coastal Walk

Sunday 11 September 9am- 11am

Enjoy sweeping coastline vistas and look for whales as you walk along Korora Beach and up to Diggers Beach headland.

A Sense of Moonee Walk

Saturday 17 September 2pm- 4pm

Watch for Ospreys as you walk along Moonee Creek estuary and enjoy the magnificent ocean views when you reach Green Bluff Headland.

A History of Coffs Creek Walk

Sunday 25 September 9:30am- 11:30am

Take a step back in time and discover why this creek has played a prominent role in our town's history, on this relaxing walk along Coffs Harbour's iconic waterway.

Koalas in Our Backyard Walk

Sunday 2 October 10am-12pm

Be surprised by the hidden beauty and tranquility of Toormina's bushland reserves that our Koalas call home.

Sawtell Coastal Walk

Sunday 16 October 10am- 12pm

Discover idyllic swimming spots with sparkling turquoise water and cool rainforest along Bonville Creek – and just 5 minutes walk to the cafés of Sawtell.

Coramba Rainforest Stroll

Saturday 22 October 9am-11am

Enjoy a leisurely stroll in the largest remaining patch of rainforest along the Orara River and be amazed by the huge trees teeming with birdlife.

Coffs Creek Walk

Sunday 6 November 10am- 11:30am

Relax on the paved walkway from The Promenade to the Botanic Gardens and discover the wildlife living in this bushland oasis.

Bruxner Park Rainforest Walk

Saturday 12 November 10am- 12pm

Experience the tranquility of this majestic rainforest with its crystal clear creek that is pure enough to drink - all only 15 minutes drive from the centre of Coffs Harbour.

Woolgoolga Lake Bush Tucker Walk

Saturday 19 November 9am- 10:30am

Discover the bush tucker and marine life of this popular coastal lake and hear tales of 'The Buster' shipwreck.

Opal Cove Walk and Food Garden Tour

Sunday 27 November 9am- 11:30am

Enjoy this walk at Opal Cove then discover the food forest created by your guide in his own backyard, that has chickens, fish and more than 100 different fruits and vegetables.
