Car parking is a primary concern within the Jetty 4 Shores project.

Parking along the edges of the Parklands improves safety through passive surveillance from adjacent areas. N.S.W Crime Prevention approved the new location of the car parks as it enables passive surveillance from traffic travelling along Jordan Esplanade and residents within the Jetty Strip units. This will reduce and deter theft and other criminal activity within the area.

Proposed walking distances range from 50 to 100 metres to beach, pier and parklands. There are also drop off zones and accessible parking included within the parking layout.

Proposed Car Parking



- There are currently 118 car parks and 3 disabled car parks within the Jetty Foreshore area
- The Jetty Foreshores design establishes 222 including 7 disabled car parks and a drop off zone
- There is potential for additional parking in overflow areas of more than 350 car parks
