B12 PROPOSAL TO CREATE ALCOHOL PROHIBITION ZONE AND ALCOHOL FREE ZONE AT COFFS HARBOUR JETTY FORESHORES

To seek Council approval for the creation of permanent Alcohol Prohibition Zone and Alcohol Free Zone at Coffs Harbour Jetty Foreshores.

- B23** **RECOMMENDED** (Hogbin/Palmer) that:

1. Council seek public consultation on the creation of Alcohol Free Zones in the areas identified on the plan attached to this report.
2. Provided the public supports the creation of the Alcohol Free Zone over the roads and carparks on the attached plan, Council implement the 24 hours/7 days per week Alcohol Free Zones from 1 July 06 to 30 September 08.
3. Council approve Alcohol Prohibition Zones from 8.00pm to 10.00am effective 1 July 2006 in the reserve areas identified on the plan attached to this report.

Councillor Ovens vacated the Chamber as he may have a conflict of interest being a potential landowner within the vicinity of the Sawtell Beach Reserve - Murray's Beach, the time being 5.10pm.

B13 SAWTELL BEACH RESERVE - MURRAY'S - ALCOHOL PROHIBITION

To recommend notices be placed to control the taking of and/or consumption of alcohol in the reserve Pt R 1002970 at the beach access in Twenty Second Avenue, Sawtell locally known as Murray's Sawtell Beach (north) and an Alcohol Free Zone be created over the adjoining section of Twenty Second Avenue, Sawtell, south of the intersection with Twentieth Avenue.

B24 RECOMMENDED (Palmer/Joass) that:

1. Council using the powers granted by S632(1)(e) of the Local Government Act 1993 prohibit 'the taking of and/or consumption of alcohol within the Pt R 1002970 Murray's beach access, Twenty Second Avenue, Sawtell between 9pm and 9am' effective from 1 July 2006.
2. Notices in accordance with the Act be installed in the location of Sawtell Beach North (Murray's beach access stairs) in Twenty Second Avenue, Sawtell.
3. Council seek public consultation on the creation of Alcohol Free Zone in the area of Twenty Second Avenue, Sawtell identified on the plan attached to this report.
4. Provided the public supports the creation of the Alcohol Free Zone, Council implement the 24 hours/7 days per week Alcohol Free Zones in Twenty Second Avenue, Sawtell, south of Twentieth Avenue from 1 July 2006 to 30 September 2008.
