Coffs Scores Awards Hat Trick

Coffs Harbour has yet again won the globally-acclaimed International Festivals and Events Association (IFEA) World Festival and Event City Award – for the third year in a row.

The award means that Coffs is once again ranked alongside some of the world's greatest cities.

Council's community leadership and focus on encouraging the success and growth of festivals and events were key reasons why an international panel of experts selected Coffs Harbour for the award.

"Attracting more and more visitors every year through the events and festivals we host is a primary goal that Council has set," said Nikki Greenwood, Council's Group Leader City Prosperity. NOTICE TO ALL WATER USERS

PERMANENT WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES APPLY FROM 1 JULY, 2015

THIS IS A PERMANENT INITIATIVE FOR OUTDOOR WATER USE EFFICIENCY

Water restrictions apply to *all* consumers connected to the Coffs Harbour Local Government Area Water Supply, including Coramba, Nana Glen and Corindi Town Water Supply Schemes.

Water Restrictions apply to **ALL RESIDENTIAL AND NON-RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES** including public areas, commercial premises, hotels/motels, holiday apartments and caravan parks, schools, plant nurseries and market gardens.

Some Permanent Water Conservation Measures are:

- **Sprinklers and Fixed/Unattended Hoses banned between the hours of 9:00am to 4:00pm**
- **Building maintenance allowed with trigger nozzle hoses or pressure cleaners**
- **Hosing of driveways and paved areas banned except for health reasons, pressure cleaners allowed**

Breaches of Permanent Water Conservation Measures or misuse of water could attract an on the spot fine of \$220.00 under the Local Government (Water Services) Regulation 1999.

Commercial organisations and businesses who are adversely affected should contact Council's Water Engineering Department on 6648 4428.

Properties that use alternative water supplies with NO town water top-up (eg bores or tanks) are to have appropriate signage, on the property being watered, clearly visible from the street.
