## NOTIFICATION – COFFS HARBOUR LOCAL ENVIRONMENTAL PLAN 2013 (AMENDMENT NO.11)

On 9 November 2017 Council adopted a Draft Amendment (cited above) to *Coffs Harbour Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2013*, applying to Lot 1 DP 777555 (1 Hamilton Drive, Boambee East). The intent of the LEP Amendment is to provide planning controls to better reflect the current use of the land as a landscaping material supplies business, and to address environmental constraints.

On 29 November 2017, the LEP Amendment was made under delegated authority by Council under Section 59 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*. On 8 December 2017 the LEP Amendment was published in the NSW Government Legislation website (2017, No 692), and is in effect from that date.

## Water Efficiency Initiative

### NOTICE TO ALL WATER USERS

#### PERMANENT WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES APPLY FROM 1 JULY, 2015

#### THIS IS A PERMANENT INITIATIVE FOR OUTDOOR WATER USE EFFICIENCY

Water restrictions apply to all consumers connected to the Coffs Harbour Local Government Area Water Supply, including Coramba, Nana Glen and Corindi Town Water Supply Schemes.

Water Restrictions apply to ALL RESIDENTIAL AND NON-RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES including public areas, commercial premises, hotels/motels, holiday apartments and caravan parks, schools, plant nurseries and market gardens.

Some Permanent Water Conservation Measures are:

- **Sprinklers and Fixed/Unattended Hoses banned between the hours of 9:00am to 4:00pm**
- **Building maintenance allowed with trigger nozzle hoses or pressure cleaners**
- **Hosing of driveways and paved areas banned except for health reasons, pressure cleaners allowed**

**Breaches of Permanent Water Conservation Measures or misuse of water could attract an on the spot fine of \$220.00 under the Local Government (Water Services) Regulation 1999.**

Properties that use alternative water supplies with NO town water top-up (eg bores or tanks) are to have appropriate signage, on the property being watered, clearly visible from the street.
