Diversity Celebrated Through Arts Grants

Ten local groups are to share \$37,400 in arts and cultural grants from Council that will bring new and exciting opportunities to celebrate the cultural diversity of the Coffs Coast community.

This year's funding round includes grants to develop a short film contrasting the experience of growing up in Coffs Harbour as opposed to passing through as a visitor, the screening of the largest science film festival in the southern hemisphere, multi-disciplinary arts projects, workshops and concerts, contemporary dance projects, a creative arts program for recently settled young people, women and children of refugee backgrounds and musical workshops with clients of Pete's Place.

Council annually offers grants from \$2,000 to \$5,000 through its Arts and Cultural

Development Grants programme to help support the implementation of the Creative Coffs - Cultural Strategic Plan 2017-2022.

"Coffs Harbour City Council's Arts and Cultural Development Grants programme is one of the most generous in regional NSW," said Coffs Harbour Mayor, Councillor Denise Knight.

"It is great to be able to offer this level of assistance to such a diverse range of projects that celebrate a variety of artistic forms and also embrace the wonderful cultural diversity we are proud to have here in Coffs Harbour."
