DRAFT BIODIVERSITY OFFSETS POLICY

On 22 March 2018 Council resolved to place the draft Biodiversity Offsets Policy on public exhibition for 28 days.

The draft Policy outlines Coffs Harbour City Council's approach to the use of biodiversity offsetting ('offsets') under the planning processes under Parts 3, 4 and 5 of the *Environment Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act)*, and the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*.
