5. Copyright in all submissions, including the winning entry remains with the entrants, except as provided by these terms and conditions.
6. You warrant your entry is your own original work.
7. You warrant your entry does not infringe or misappropriate any Indigenous cultural or intellectual property.
8. By submitting a logo design and or tagline and accepting the prize offered for category winners, the winning entrant will grant the City of Coffs Harbour a permanent, irrevocable, ongoing, royalty-free, exclusive licence to use reproduce, distribute, adapt, and modify the winning logo or tagline.
9. You warrant there are no impediments that prevents the winning logo and/or tagline being published or reproduced.
10. You agree to indemnify Council against all costs and expenses (including reasonable legal fees) incurred by the Council in connection with any claim against the Council that your entry is not an original creation or infringes upon a third party's copyright, or infringes or misappropriates Indigenous cultural or intellectual property.
