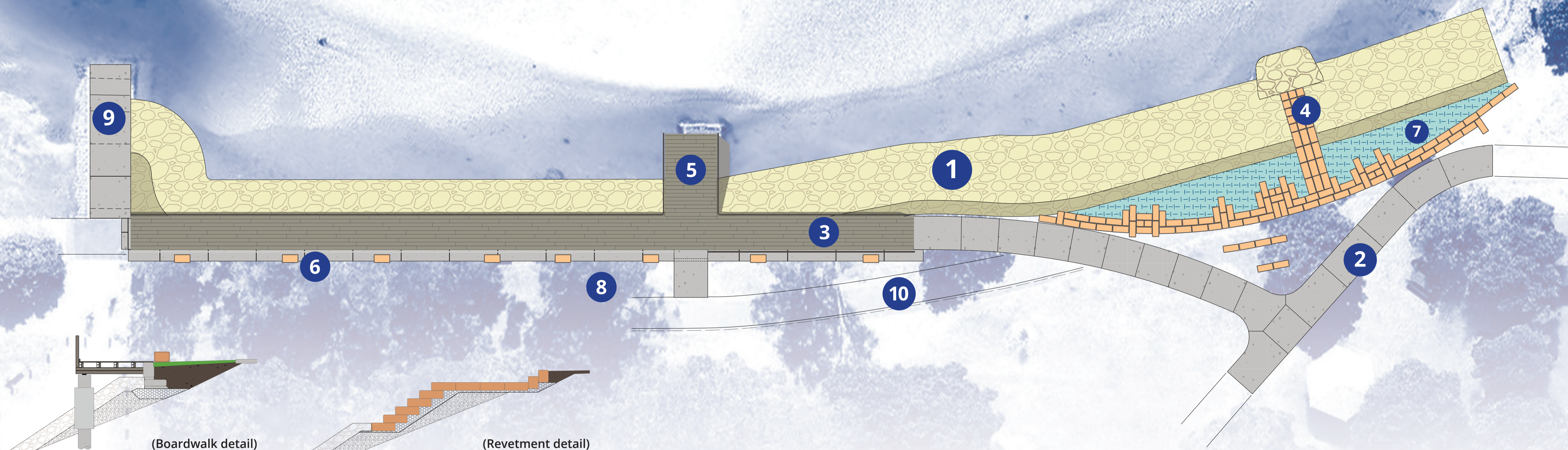


Coffs Creek Protection Project

A permanent rock retaining wall is being constructed as part of this project to prevent erosion and protect the waterway. This project will also benefit community by providing a new footpath and boardwalk to improve pedestrian access, as well as a new jetty pier and seating space for everyone to enjoy the area.



Upgrades

1. Rock protection slope to protect from coastal erosion
2. New footpath to link to the existing path
3. New boardwalk
4. Sandstone steps provide access to the intertidal sand flats
5. New Jetty pier with steps providing access to the creek
6. New sandstone seating
7. Re-establish salt marsh areas
8. New shade trees
9. Existing boat ramp to be retained
10. Existing footpath to be retained

Timeline

-  **March 2024** - Construction Commences
-  **September 2024** - Complete (weather permitting)
