Landcare is a voluntary community movement of about 4,500 groups across Australia which has grown considerably since its inception in 1989. Farmers manage 60 per cent of Australia's land and 70 per cent of its diverted water. About 40 per cent of farmers are involved in LandCare.

The LandCare ethic is straightforward and practical - working together as a community to help create a healthy environment now and for the future.

Landcare projects focus on improving environmental health in natural systems including bushland, rivers and wetlands, both on farms and in urban areas. Landcare projects aim to improve the local environment through:

- controlling weeds and establishing native vegetation;
- addressing soil erosion and improving the health of the soil; and
- creating food, shelter and habitat for our local wildlife.
