## Critical danger water shortage

Schools, sportsgrounds and public gardens	<ul> <li>Recycled water can be used outdoors for watering</li> <li>No use of town water allowed outside</li> </ul>
Market gardens, orchards, nurseries and commercial flower gardens	<ul> <li>Approval from City of Coffs Harbour is required to use sprinklers, fixed, unattended and handheld hoses for a maximum of 30 minutes on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays</li> <li>No watering with town water allowed at other times, or without approval</li> </ul>
Swimming pools, spas and outdoor showers (including motels, resorts, parks etc)	<ul> <li>No topping up or filling of pools and spas allowed</li> <li>No use of outdoor or beach showers allowed.</li> </ul>
Vehicle washing  Category A – buses, taxis, food transport, ambulance and garbage vehicles.  Category B – all other vehicles	<ul> <li>Category A vehicles need to apply for approval from City of Coffs         Harbour to use hoses for a maximum of 15 minutes on Monday,         Wednesdays and Fridays for health and safety reasons only</li> <li>No use of town water allowed at other times or without approval</li> <li>Category B vehicles only allowed to wash vehicles if required by law</li> </ul>
Pressure and carpet cleaning, car detailing and under-boring	- All activities require approval from City of Coffs Harbour
Paved public areas	- No hosing or pressure cleaning, except where required by law
Building and new turf	<ul> <li>All external building uses of town water require approval from City of Coffs Harbour</li> <li>No use of town water allowed at other times or without approval</li> <li>No watering of turf allowed</li> </ul>
