Swimming pools, spas and outdoor showers (including motels, resorts, parks etc.)	- No restrictions
Vehicle washing Category A – buses, taxis, food transport, ambulance and garbage vehicles. Category B – all other vehicles	- No restrictions
Pressure and carpet cleaning, car detailing and under-boring	- No restrictions
Paved public areas	 Hosing or pressure cleaning allowed where food is prepared and/or consumed for health and safety reasons No hosing of hardstand areas for other reasons allowed
Building and new turf	 All building uses allowed New turf Handheld hoses allowed while planting or laying turf Approval by City of Coffs Harbour required to use sprinklers on new turf for a maximum of 1 hour a day for 7 days after laying / planting No use of town water allowed at other times or without approval
