| Building and new turf  | <ul> <li>All building uses allowed</li> <li>New turf         <ul> <li>Hand held hoses allowed during planting or laying</li> <li>Approval by City of Coffs Harbour required to use sprinklers on new turf for a maximum of 1 hour a day for up to 7 days after laying / planting.</li> </ul> </li> <li>No use of town water allowed at other times or without approval</li> </ul> |
