LEVEL 3 WATER RESTRICTIONS GUIDE



Very high danger water shortage

Schools, sportsgrounds and public gardens	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Sprinklers allowed Monday, Wednesday and Friday between 7.30am and 8am- No watering with town water allowed at other times
Market gardens, orchards, nurseries and commercial flower gardens	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Approval by City of Coffs Harbour required to use sprinklers, fixed, unattended and handheld hoses for a maximum 1 hour a day- No use of town water allowed at other times or without approval
Swimming pools, spas and outdoor showers (including motels, resorts, parks etc)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Topping up of pools allowed- Filling of spas allowed- No use of outdoor or beach showers allowed
Vehicle washing <i>Category A – buses, taxis, food transport, ambulance and garbage vehicles.</i> <i>Category B – all other vehicles</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- <i>Category A</i> vehicles – Approval by City of Coffs Harbour required.- <i>Category B</i> vehicles – handheld hoses allowed on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays between 9am and 9:30am- No use of town water allowed at other times or without approval
Pressure and carpet cleaning, car detailing and under-boring	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- No pressure cleaning or hosing of driveways, paved or hardstand areas
Paved public areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Hosing or pressure cleaning allowed<ul style="list-style-type: none">- where food is prepared and/or consumed- for health and safety reasons
Building and new turf	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- All building uses allowed- New turf<ul style="list-style-type: none">- handheld hoses allowed <i>during</i> planting or laying turf only- watering with bucket and watering cans allowed at other times- No use of town water allowed at other times
