Schools, sportsgrounds and public gardens	 Sprinklers and fixed or unattended hoses allowed before 9am and after 4pm Handheld hoses can be used at any time
Market gardens, orchards, nurseries and commercial flower gardens	 Sprinklers and fixed or unattended hoses allowed before 9am and after 4pm Handheld hoses can be used at any time
Swimming pools, spas and outdoor showers (including motels, resorts, parks etc.)	- No restrictions
Vehicle washing Category A – buses, taxis, food transport, ambulance and garbage vehicles. Category B – all other vehicles	- No restrictions
Pressure and carpet cleaning, car detailing and under-boring	- No restrictions
Paved public areas	 Hosing or pressure cleaning allowed where food is prepared and/or consumed for health and safety reasons No hosing of hardstand areas for any other reason
Building and new turf	 All building uses allowed Sprinklers allowed on new turf any time on the day of planting or laying Sprinklers allowed on turf before 9am and after 4pm Handheld hose is allowed at any time
