

Artefacts (JB) Repatriation event will be held next Wednesday 1 March, an invite will be sent to the YAAC by the GM City of Coffs Harbour (City), this event is not open to the general public. Background Chris Davie Executive Officer of Australian Institute of Archaeologists will hand back a collection of over 330 artefacts collected in the 1960s by archaeologist William Rogers to Garby and Gumbaynggirr elders, in line with Cultural Heritage Act. Elders have decided on the City of Coffs Harbour Museum as a place for safe keeping through a Deed of Deposit until a new place is decided upon by elders in the future. 2 drawers of artefacts will be displayed in the Yarrila building which will have a plaque to acknowledge the traditional owners. YAAC thanked the City's curator (JB) for her great work on this project and acknowledged both her work and the approach she has taken. 	Noted
